The accommodation in this school is  
 for 82 older scholars and 43 infants. On  
 Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> October, 1917, there were 88  
 older children present and 49 infants; altogether  
 there are 143 names on the registers and the  
 average attendance during the month of October  
 has been 134.

The seating accommodation for older scholars  
 is insufficient for 3 children sat in each of  
 nine dual desks when the school was visited.

The school, it is understood, is intended as  
 a Junior Department with Standard IV as the  
 highest standard and from it the older  
 scholars should be drafted to the Boys' &
