# Spring Term

In **literacy** this term we are focusing on improving the interest levels in sentences by focusing on choosing a range of different connectives.  
☺ You can help your child in this by discussing the way that authors have used connectives to link sentences or sequence events, arguments etc.

In **maths** we are particularly focusing on strengthening children's times tables knowledge. There will be a weekly test on random tables up to 12x12.  
☺ You can help your child in this by encouraging them to learn their times tables and the related division facts

## Numeracy

- Multiply two digit numbers and three digit numbers using short multiplication.
- Subtract numbers with up to four digits using the decomposition method
- Solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities.
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator
- Round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number.
- **Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12x12**
- Identify acute and obtuse angles
- Convert between different units of measure (kilometre to metre, hour to minute, gram to kilogram)
- Develop problem solving and reasoning skills.



## Geography

### Focus on (i) Weather and climates

- Different types of weather and climate – UK and worldwide
- How climate affects plants and animals
- Why there are different climates
- Investigate different climate types in greater detail
- Biomes

## History

### Focus on

- Human effect on climates and biomes though time.

## Literacy

Looking at a range of genre, to include:-

- Information texts including dictionary and thesaurus tasks
- Stories which raise issues/dilemma's – look at how characters respond to dilemma's, explore alternative actions
- Explanation texts
- Writing in paragraphs.
- Practise handwriting and spelling, developing a variety of strategies to help.
- Investigate additional words which are used to connect sentences.
- Write complex sentences

## Science

### Focus on (i) sound(ii) Animals including humans

- Know all sounds made by objects vibrating.
- Sound travels through solids, liquids, gases
- Structure of the ear & hearing.
- Investigate pitch and volume and investigate soundproofing.
- Know the seven characteristics of a living thing
- Micro-habitats
- How living things are classified
- Investigate predators and prey.
- Investigate food chains and webs



## Religious Education

- (ii) **Is forgiveness always possible?**
