Four Square Competition

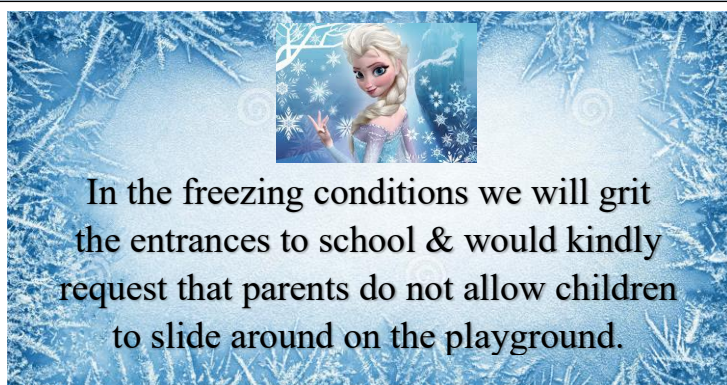
