## Volleyball Anyone?



On behalf of Calne Volleyball Club, we are an established family club with a junior section that enters tournaments on a local, divisional and national basis, we also have 2 teams in the Wiltshire senior mixed league and a team in the ladies and junior Wiltshire league. We currently have 2 juniors playing for the Junior Southwest England team as well as multiple seniors playing for the counties national league side!

At the club we have registered coaches who are fully insured, and all DBS registered to work with juniors.

Our main aim is to increase the numbers of people whom enjoy playing volleyball and we aim to do this by increasing our regular junior participants as any successful sports club endeavours to do.

We do appreciate that Volleyball is not a mainstream sport, but it teaches fantastic team values and disciplines allowing young people to develop positive attitude to teamwork, hard work and physical activity. You should also be aware that experience shows us that people who do not necessarily enjoy other sports can thrive in Volleyball, and as this is a family club, participants find that we create a positive environment to be part of.

With all of this in mind we are holding a FREE taster session [from 19:00-20:00 on Friday 16th of November](#) for ages 6-16 at Calne leisure centre. This is specifically a junior taster session with an adult training session afterwards which we encourage juniors (and parents) to stay and watch so they can appreciate what established volleyball players can do.
