As you know, funding for schools is extremely tight; at Holy Trinity we are currently experiencing an in-year deficit of £10,000. Swimming and Residential trips have to be paid by us at the beginning of the school year in a large lump sum. Even though all contributions are voluntary, we will have to find the money somewhere. In the future this may mean scaling back swimming, rethinking our Residential and school visits provision and may mean prioritising which essential resources we have to do without.

We are extremely grateful to the Friends Committee for their fundraising efforts. They are now funding educational resources that used to come out of the main school budget, such as atlases, i-pads and dictionaries. The Friends have subsidised all school visits for the last two years.
