NATIONAL INCREASE IN SCARLET FEVER

Public Health England would like to remind all parents of the signs and symptoms of Scarlet Fever and the actions to be taken in case of an outbreak. Early symptoms include sore throat, headache, fever, nausea and vomiting. After 12-48 hours the characteristic red, pinhead rash develops, typically first on the chest and stomach, then rapidly spreading to other parts of the body. The skin has a 'sandpaper' feel.

Children and adults with suspected Scarlet Fever should be *excluded from school/work for 24 hours after starting antibiotic treatment.*

Good hygiene practice such as frequent hand washing remains the most important step in preventing and controlling the spread of infection.
