<p>Using natural resources (twigs, leaves, rocks etc.), create an Easter themed piece of wild art.</p> 	<p>Have an egg and spoon race with your family. You could use something else instead of an egg or add in obstacles for a challenge</p>	<p>Create an acrostic poem from the word Easter and illustrate it</p>
<p>Play a board game with your family.</p> <p>Maybe you could invent an Easter themed board game!</p>	<p>Go for a walk and count how many rainbow paintings you can see in the front windows of houses.</p> 	<p>Take a virtual tour of a museum. Maybe you could visit the Natural History museum in London for example.</p>
<p>Use a potato or carrot to make an Easter paint stamper</p>	<p>Have a go at the raisin box challenge – how many objects can you fit in one raisin box?</p>	<p>Make something Easter themed out of Lego bricks.</p> <p>Can you make a bunny, or a chick, or maybe a carrot?</p>
<p>Make an Easter themed junk model using recycled materials (e.g. cereal packets, plastic tubs and bottle tops)</p>	<p>Can you create some Easter bunting to hang up in your house or garden?
