Dear Parents/Carers,

Following yesterday's announcement, we will be commencing remote learning for all children tomorrow. Each year group will have the following tasks assigned to them on Seesaw **each** day:

- Literacy (this may be writing, or reading comprehension)
- Mathematics
- An activity from one of the following subjects: PSHE, Science, Geography/History, RE, Art

In addition, the children should be encouraged to read **every** day. We have attached our latest Recommended Reading list as part of this email. You may also like to share books with your child. Furthermore, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children will receive a daily Phonics lesson and Key Stage 2 children will have spelling activities to complete during the week. We also hope that the children will be able to have some form of daily exercise with you, but we will not be setting any specific PE activities.

Class teachers will endeavour to upload the assignments on Seesaw the day before they are to be completed; for example, work for Tuesday should be uploaded by Monday evening. Instructions for the assignments may be written or may include a short video or audio clip.

Work should be completed either on the template given or, if you prefer, on a print-out or piece of paper, which can then be photographed and uploaded. It should be completed on the day set and submitted before 3pm. Teachers will mark work and give feedback, but as they are also teaching the key worker and vulnerable children who are attending school, this may not always be immediate. If there is a problem with any of the work set for your child, please send a message on Seesaw and we will endeavour to reply as soon as possible.

We know that home learning can be very stressful, particularly if parents are continuing to work. The emphasis is firmly on 'best endeavours', so that learning continues to be enjoyable and we build life-long learners. All children learn at different rates and may prefer to work at a specific time during the day. Each day's activities should take up to three hours – please annotate any work that you have scaffolded for your child.

Once again, we thank you for your support of Holy Trinity and the children.
