Dear Parents and Carers,

On Monday evening (14th June), the Prime Minister gave a press conference to announce a 4-week pause at Step 3 in England until 19 July. This has prevented us running our usual menu of school events for the Summer (for example, the Summer Fayre, End of Year Church Service at St Mary's, educational visits, etc). **We will maintain our current protective measures controls that are currently in place until there is a further announcement on Stage 4 of the roadmap.**

We have discussed our planned events with Wiltshire Health and Safety and with other headteachers in the local Calne cluster of schools. **The following events may be cancelled at short notice, if there are any Covid outbreaks or if Government and/or Public Health England guidance changes.**

Sports Day

Sports Day will go ahead this academic year in bubbles, but without spectators. We feel that it is vital to run some sort of Sports Day, as the Year 1 and Reception children have not yet taken part in one and all the children missed out last year.

- Bubble 2 (Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3) - Wednesday 7th July 2021 (pm)
- Bubble 1 (Reception) – Friday 9th July (am)
- Bubble 3 (Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6) - Tuesday 20th July 2021 (pm)

Year 6 Summer Performance

Year 6 will be performing their Summer Performance of 'The Next Big Step' over two nights in the school hall.

- Wednesday 14th July at 6.30pm
- Thursday 15th July at 6.30pm



Year 6 parents will be given up to two tickets and will be assigned a set evening. Each pair will be seated in designated seats so that they are socially distanced. Parents will not be able to choose which performance they attend. We politely request that parents take a lateral flow test on the evening before they are scheduled to come on to the school site and engage with the NHS Track and Trace App. All surfaces and objects will be cleaned thoroughly and the school's system of controls will be applied robustly. Hand sanitiser will be made available. Further details will be released nearer the time.

The rest of the school will view a recorded performance during this term.

Year 6 Leavers Night

Mrs Brown and I will be discussing this in the next few days. We are hoping that we will be able to host much of this event outside, although this will be dependent as always on the weather. Please could parents make a note of the prospective date for this, which will be Friday 16th July at 6pm. We will confirm the details as soon as we can.

Year 6 leavers service

The Year 6 Leavers Service will be held on the last day of term – Thursday 22nd July at 2pm. Year 6 parents will be given two tickets and assigned designated seats. We will again ask parents to take a lateral flow test on the evening before the service and engage with the NHS Track and Trace App. We are hoping that stage 4 of the Government's Road Map will be in place by then. The whole school and staff will be unable to attend this event.

The events listed above will be pared-down versions of what we would really like to do. However, it is important to try to put these events on to celebrate the Year 6 children's seven years at Holy Trinity. It is a lasting regret that we were unable to do this for last year's Year 6 cohort.
