Dear Parents and Carers,

**Our current measures will remain in place for this academic year, despite the country's movement to Step 4 of the roadmap on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July.**

From September 2021, all children will come into school from 8.45am. The school day will conclude at 3.30pm for all the children. Reception, Year 2 and Year 4 will continue to access the school from their external doors that lead on to the school car park. Year 1, Year 3, Year 5 and Year 6 will access the school from the back gate. We will continue to follow Government and Public Health guidance; our Risk Assessment will be continually updated in line with this.

Children will not be kept in bubbles and will have shared break times and lunch times. Face coverings can be worn, but this will be a personal choice for parents coming on to the school site. Staff will not wear face masks in communal areas.

We will continue to ensure that the following control measures are in place:

- Ensure good hygiene for everyone.
- Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes.
- Keep occupied spaces well ventilated.
- Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19

It may be necessary to reintroduce Covid-19 precautions based on Government and Public Health guidance. In this instance, we will continue to follow guidance from health professionals, Government and the latest version of the Schools Internal Actions Card from Wiltshire Local Authority.
